ADDITIONAL Superintendent of Police A G Kariappa has asked autorickshaw drivers to follow traffic rules and said Rapido bike taxis should follow the order of the Karnataka High Court and not take to the road illegally.

A meeting was jointly organised by the Shivamogga District Police and the Shivamogga Regional Transport Department (RTD) with auto drivers and rapido bike taxi drivers at the Shivamogga Traffic Circle office here on Tuesday. ASP Cariappa warned the autorickshaw drivers to ensure that all documents related to

their vehicles are valid. "The FC of some rented autorickshaws running in the city have expired. So, get it renewed immediately and adhere to the traffic rules to avoid the complaints," he said.

At the meeting, the police applauded those autorickshaw drivers who have returned mobile phones and belongings that were left in the auto by the passengers.

Four airports in Karnataka developed under GFA Policy: MP

THE Union Civil Aviation Minister has said that as per Greenfield Airports (GFA) Policy, 2008, Government of India (GoI) granted 'In-Principle' approval in June, 2008 to the State Government of Karnataka (GoK) for development of four Greenfield airports at Kalaburagi, Shivamogga, Vijayapura and Hassan in Karnataka.

Replying to a starred question of MP GC Chandrashekar in Rajya Sabha, Union minister of Civil Aviation K. Jaganmohan Reddy said, Out of Four, two Greenfield airports at Kalaburagi and Shivamogga have been operationalized. Further, development of Vijayapura and Hassan airport projects is under progress by State Government through its Karnataka State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (KSIIDC).

The development works have been completed at Vijayapura airport. However, matter of grant of Environmental Clearance (EC) to this project under violation category is sub-judice before the Supreme Court of India.

Development and operationalisation of Hassan Airport is subject to all applicable regulatory approvals including EC. Further, the responsibility for implementation of the Greenfield airport projects lies with the Project Proponent, as per GFA Policy. The timeline for completion of the airport projects depend upon several factors such as land acquisition, R&R, financial closure, obtaining mandatory clearances including EC etc.

However, Ministry of Civil Aviation reviews these projects periodically with stakeholders including GoK for timely completion, said minister.

Maize procurement to begin from today

THE much awaited maize procurement centre is going to start in the district from Wednesday. Maize grown by farmers during the current monsoon season will be purchased from today, said Deputy Commissioner (DC) Gangadharaswamy G M. Speaking after a meeting on maize procurement held at the DC's office, he said maize produce will be purchased from each farmer at a

support price of Rs 2,400 per quintal and a minimum of 12 quintals per acre and a maximum of 50 quintals will be procured. Maize buyers will pay the amount to the farmers concerned through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) within three days from the date of receipt of the sale amount from the distillery owners. NCDEX e Markets Limited (NEML) will be responsible for the procurement process. The DC asked the officials concerned to take action to carry out the registra-

tion of farmers with the integration of DBT. The district has set a target of purchasing 730 metric tonnes of maize.

He asked farmers to sell maize at the procurement centre and take advantage of this. The Cooperation Department and APMC officials should print leaflets with information about maize procurement and give them to the farmers. He asked the officials to take action, so that there is no confusion in the procurement of maize.

HM: Nyamathi to get new fire and emergency station

Home Minister Dr G Parameshwar on Tuesday announced that the newly formed Nyamathi taluk will be getting a fire and emergency services station shortly.

In a written reply to a question by Honnali Nyamathi MLA DG Shanthanagowda in the state legislative assembly, Home Minister said that the new station is coming-up in the list of 21 new fire stations that are being constructed under the support of the 15th finance commission grants provided by the central government.

The minister also said that the government has also reserved 1.10 acres on the main road in the survey number 135/P and the title has been transferred in the name of the fire and emergency services.

He said, in principle approval has been given for the construction of the building and other necessary infrastructure needed for the setting-up of the fire station across 21 places in Karnataka and Karnataka State Police Housing and infrastructure development corporation has been awarded to construct these buildings, he added.

Minister also said that the construction for the 18 buildings have been given administrative approval on November 18, 2025 and the construction of the buildings will start immediately.

Ever since the Nyamathi taluk was carved out of the Honnali, the taluk is in need of basic infrastructure and the government is providing them, said MLA Shanthanagowda.

CONSTRUCTION WORKERS' BOARD

Forum demands probe into corruption charges

THE Karnataka State Building and Other Construction Workers (KSBOCW) Welfare Board on Tuesday urged Chief Minister Siddaramaiah to fulfill various demands of registered construction workers.

The workers, who staged a protest in front of the DC's office, submitted a memorandum to the government through the DC in which they said that 18 years have passed since the Karnataka State Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board was started. Since 2023, there has been massive corruption in the board and they demanded an order to investigate all the projects for which tenders have been awarded.

"With various amendments to the law, the registered construction workers are getting better facilities. However, many eligible beneficiaries have been dropped from the eligible list which has to be rectified. Along with this, ineligibility should be repelled from the list," they urged.

"Since 2023, after Santosh Lad became the Labour Minister, he has cut many facilities provided by the Board to registered construction workers and implemented schemes

that are not needed by registered construction workers. An estimated Rs 4,000 crore has been spent so far and thousands of crores of rupees have been given to private agencies that have won tenders. This is how Lad looted the cess money of registered construction workers. The CAG (Comptroller and Auditor General of India) has exposed the corruption of the Board in the report issued by the department that audits all the expenditure of the Central and state governments," they said.

"It has been reported that all the tender programmes implemented by the Board are bogus programmes. The scholarship of the children of registered construction workers has become a mirage. Pension for the disabled and retirement pension are being given once a year," they said.

Along with these various facilities like kits and medical benefits, other issues are also not addressed properly, they said.

The state president of Karnataka Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Association, J Manjunath, general secretary Y Kumar, vice-presidents K Ghouse Peer, Nadia Ali, Narasimharaju and others took part in the protest.
