

Man dies by suicide inaisalmer district

Jaisalmer: A man in Jaisalmer district died by suicide Sunday after filing a police complaint alleging sexual harassment of his minor daughter, police said. The man, a resident of the Lathi police station area, lodged the report Saturday night, accusing a boy from the village of sexually harassing his daughter for some time. Police told his action would be taken by Sunday morning, officials said.

Court Grants Interim Protection to House

Jaisalmer: The Rajasthan High Court has stayed demolition of a house from taking coercive action against a residential property in Bharatpur allegedly targeted during a road-widening drive without due process. A single judge bench of Justice Anuroop Singh passed the order on April 23, the copy of which was uploaded Monday. The court issued no notice to the state government through the principal secretary, urban development and housing, Bharatpur district collector, Bharatpur District Development Authority, commissioner of Nagar Nigam Bharatpur, and the executive engineer of the Public Works Department, seeking replies within six weeks. The writ petition was filed by Dhiraendra Singh, who alleged that officials arbitrarily demolished the boundary wall of his house in Subhash Nagar Phase-II, Bharatpur, and threatened

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Woman, two goats killed in SUV hit-and-run

Jaisalmer: A woman and two goats were killed in a hit-and-run accident on Monday morning, police said. The woman was identified as Badli Devi, wife of Krishnamurthy, a resident of Bawdi Kaland village in Chauthan. She was heading to the fields to graze goats when the accident occurred at Bawdi Kaland (Meetha Ka Tala village) in the Dhanu police station area.

Police said the crash happened about one kilometre from Bawdi village towards Dhanu when the Bolero Camper, coming from the posted direction, struck her and the goats. Badli Devi and two goats died on the spot. Hearing the impact, locals rushed to the site. Police said the driver was leaving the vehicle and its goods on the road.

Dhanu police reached the spot and seized the Bolero Camper. Badli Devi was taken to Chauthan Hospital, where doctors declared her dead. Her son, Shrawan Kumar, filed a report. After the post-mortem, the body was handed over to the family. Police said further investigation is ongoing.

Mining plan approval will now be granted in Udaipur, Aimer

Jaisalmer: The Indian Bureau of Mines has provided significant relief to mining lease holders in Rajasthan, according to a notification issued by the central govt.

Now, small mine owners in the state will no longer have to make repeated visits to higher offices for the approval of their mining plans, thereby easing a long-standing procedural burden that often led to delays and inconvenience. The order issued by Controller General of the IBM, reads "Mining plans for quartz, felspar, mica and barytes mines with a less than area of five hectares or less can now be directly approved from the regional office located in Udaipur and Aimer, a move that is aimed at improving administrative efficiency, reducing delays in clearances, and decentralising the approval process for smaller mining operations."

Earlier, this system was largely centralised under a limited jurisdiction, primarily divided into two clearly defined administrative zones.

Under the Udaipur regional office, mining plans for leases up to five hectares located in Salumber, Amer, Rajasmand, Udaipur, Chittorgarh, Nimbarhara, Sirohi, Banswara, Pratnagar, Dungarpur, Sojat City, Barmer, and Jaisalmer districts will now be processed and approved at the Udaipur office itself. Mining plans for quartz, felspar, mica and barytes mines located in Bhujra, along with all other remaining districts and urban areas of Rajasthan not covered under the Udaipur jurisdiction, will fall under the Aimer regional office, where approvals will continue to be granted, with the bifurcation expected to streamline operations and improve turnaround time for applicants.

month due to runway repair work. The first flight, IndiGo service from Bengaluru, is scheduled to arrive at 8.45am.
