TN CM for action on Mekedatu proj

Vijay met PM Modi to discuss key Tamil Nadu issues and the Tamil invocation song controversy.

NEW DELHI: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister C Joseph Vijay met Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday and discussed matters concerning the state, including the Mekedatu dam issue, fishermen arrests and the Tamil invocation song row.

In addition, Vijay also met Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and handed over a memorandum to prioritise funding for ports, national highways, railway projects and industrial corridors that are crucial for Tamil Nadu's development.

This was Vijay's maiden official visit to the national capital after assuming office. His meeting with the PM and the Sitharaman comes days after his party TVK secured an upset win in the April 23 Assembly polls, defeating Dravidian heavyweights DMK and AIADMK and formed its government with the support of allies including VCK. The CM



raised the issue of the Tamil Thai Vazhthu (invocation) song, as a controversy had broke out over the sequence of playing it third-- after Vande Mataram and National anthem in the swearing-in ceremony of his government as well as the expansion of his cabinet.

In a letter addressed to PM Modi, Vijay said, "at the outset, I wish to affirm that the Government and people of Tamil Nadu hold the National Anthem and the National Song in the highest

esteem."
"Tamil Nadu has consistently upheld the dignity and decorum associated with all national symbols and remains deeply committed to the unity, integrity and constitutional values of India. I would also like to bring to your kind notice the long-established position of Tamil Thai Vazhthu in the public life of Tamil Nadu," he said in the letter. For several decades, it has traditionally been rendered at the commencement of gov-

ernment, educational, cultural and public functions across Tamil Nadu and the practice has also been formally recognised by the Tamil Nadu government, he said.

"Following the issuance of the above Ministry of Home Affairs order, Lok Bhavan has adopted the sequence of Vande Mataram, National Anthem and thereafter Tamil Thai Vazhthu. The placement of Tamil Thai Vazhthu subsequent to the National Anthem has led to widespread public concern and opposition from various sections of society in Tamil Nadu, as it departs from the long-standing and officially recognised practice followed in the State."

Assam passes UCC Bill

GUWAHATI: The Assam Assembly on Wednesday passed the UCC Bill that seeks to put in place a common legal framework to govern marriage, divorce, succession and live-in relationships irrespective of religion, even as the opposition demanded that it be sent to a select committee.

With the passage of the proposed legislation, Assam became the third state, after Uttarakhand and Gujarat, to pass a Uniform Civil Code Bill. Goa also has one common civil law, which continued from its erstwhile Portuguese colonial period.

After a day-long discussion on the 'The Uniform Civil Code, Assam, 2026 Bill', Speaker Ranjeet Kumar Dass asked Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma to move it for passage.

Dass rejected the opposition's demand that the Bill be sent to a select committee for wider consultation, prompting them to move to the Well of the House and keep on shouting till the Bill was passed. As the opposition did not move the amendments it had raised, the Speaker put the Bill for voice voting, amid continuous slogans of 'Bharat Mata Ki Jai' and 'Jai Shree Ram' by the ruling bench.

INTERACTION WITH TRAINEE OFFICERS

'Technology must be used for improving trust between citizens, institutions'

NEW DELHI: Union Minister Jitendra Singh on Wednesday told a group of civil servants that technology must be used not merely for efficiency but also for improving trust between citizens and institutions.

Interacting with trainee officers of the 2024 batch of the Indian Administrative Service (IAS) here, he said modern governance no longer functions through rigid hierarchies and one-way communication.

Singh, the Minister of State for Personnel, encouraged the officers to remain open-minded learners throughout their careers, saying the ability to adapt, unlearn and evolve is now more valuable than static knowledge.

He said the nature of administration has changed significantly in the last decade with greater emphasis on transparency, responsiveness and citizen participation.

Referring to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's philosophy of "maximum governance, minimum government," the minister said technology must be used not merely for efficiency but also for improving trust



between citizens and institutions.

Singh said future administrators would be expected to combine technological competence with empathy, sensitivity and ethical public conduct.

During the interaction, the minister also exchanged views with the trainee officers on district administration, governance challenges, leadership responsibilities and changing public expectations from civil servants.

He encouraged them to maintain neutrality, remain accessible to citizens and focus on meaningful public outcomes rather than visibility.

Watery grave

SAMBHAL: An 18-year-old man allegedly drowned while bathing in a swimming pool in a village in Nakhasa area of the district, police said on Wednesday.

Police have registered a case against the pool operators and an unidentified person, and have taken up an investigation.

In a purported video of the incident that went viral on the internet, a man was seen forcibly putting the victim's head in the pool. The police, however, did comment on the video, saying that a detailed probe is on.

Additional Superintendent of Police (North) Kuldeep Singh said that on Monday, Suhail Ahmad, 18, a resident of Rehmapur Pipli village, had gone to bathe at a swimming pool owned by Haji Maqsood along with his two cousins.

He said Suhail drowned while bathing at around 1.15 pm. Family members rushed him to Haseena Begum Hospital, where doctors declared him dead.
