Circle Conference of BSNL Employees Union held at Port Blair



SRI VIJAYA PURAM, MAY 25/--/ The 8th Andaman and Nicobar Circle Conference of the BSNL Employees Union was held at Sun Sea Resort, Port Blair on 24th May, 2026. In the inaugural session, the Conference was inaugurated by M. Vijayakumar, All India President of BSNL Employees Union. Speaking on the occasion, he briefly explained the ongoing war in the gulf region and the disastrous consequences on the poor people in the country. Vijayakumar came down heavily on the Modi government for privatising public sector undertakings in the country one by one. He said that due to the wrong policies of the successive central government, the BSNL is now at the brink of collapse. He said that the wage revision of BSNL employees is due from 2017 onwards, but the central government is not taking any positive steps to go for the wage revision despite nation-wide joint agitation by employees and officers in the BSNL.

The Conference began with the hoisting of the Union's flag by M. Vijayakumar, All India President which was followed paying floral tributes to martyrs at the specially erected Martyrs Memorial Column. In the Delegate Session, SP Kalairajan, Circle Secretary moved the condolence resolution. He also presented the working report on the functioning of the Union since its last Circle Conference held in September 2022. The Audited Accounts was presented by T. Abbas, Treasurer. M. Rajendran, Circle President, A&N Circle presided over the Delegate Session. Members participated in the discussion on the report which was subsequently adopted unanimously by the Delegate Session.

Chittaranjan Biswas, Asst Circle Secretary presented the resolutions on various demands of BSNL Employees, which were adopted by the session

after discussion. A new Circle Committee with M. Rajendran as President, SP Kalairajan as Circle Secretary and Abdul Aziz as Treasurer was also elected in the Delegate Session. In the Open Session of the Conference, Shri VS Ilanthirai, ITS, Chief General Manager, A & N Telecom Circle was the Chief Guest while B. SC agrees to hear plea on Rs 500 cr UAE money decree in July as mediation fails

NEW DELHI, MAY 25: Taking note of a failed mediation process undertaken by former Chief Justice of India U Lalit, the Supreme Court on Monday agreed to hear in July a plea related to the execution of a money decree of Rs 500 crore passed by a UAE court in favour of Ras Al Khaimah Investment Authority and against Hyderabad-based industrialist Nimmagadda Prasad. At the outset, senior advocate Abhishek Singhvi, appearing for Ras Al Khaimah Investment Authority (RAKIA), informed a bench comprising Chief Justice Surya Kant and Justices Joymalya Bagchi and Vipul M Pancholi that the mediation process has failed and the matter be now heard by the court itself in July. On March 16, the CJI-led bench had appointed U Lalit as the sole mediator to amicably resolve the dispute over the execution of a money decree of Rs 500 crore passed by the UAE court in favour of RAKIA and against Prasad. The bench, on Monday, said that it is not going to hear interim applications at the moment and will accord day-to-day hearing on the main case in the second week of July. RAKIA is seeking to enforce a UAE civil judgment for 267,941,374 dirham (approximately Rs 543 crore principal and Rs 643 crore with interest). The case stems from the 'Vanpik Project', a failed 2008 joint venture to develop ports and an airport in Andhra Pradesh. RAKIA has alleged that Prasad, in collusion with former RAKIA CEO Khater Massaad, misappropriated USD 120 million intended for the project. Senior advocate Gopal Subramaniam, appearing for Prasad, had earlier informed the bench that the industrialist deposited Rs 125 crore as cash security as directed through a previous order. The senior lawyer also said that the original title deeds of a 37-acre land parcel in Telangana have also been submitted in the court.
