

Dilapidated roads leading to public inconvenience at Dharmanagar town

Dharmanagar, May 27: Residents of Dharmanagar town in North Tripura are facing growing hardships due to the deteriorating condition of roads across the town, with public anger mounting over what many described as administrative inaction and neglect. Roads riddled with

potholes, large craters and waterlogging after even light rainfall have made daily commuting increasingly difficult for residents. The situation has become particularly alarming in the stretch from Rajbari shopping mall to the Rajbari bridge area, where locals claim the damaged roads have turned into a 'death

trap'. According to residents, rainwater often covers deep potholes, making it difficult for commuters to assess the depth and danger of the damaged stretches. As a result, people are forced to travel under constant fear of accidents. Locals alleged that minor mishaps have become a regular occurrence, including e-rickshaws overturning, motorcycles skidding and frequent road accidents. Drivers, e-rickshaw operators and pedestrians alike are reportedly struggling to navigate the broken roads. The situation becomes even more dangerous after dark, when poor visibility adds to the risk of serious accidents, residents said. People of the town have alleged that despite the poor condition of roads persisting for a long period, no effective repair work or concrete administrative action has been visible. They said that while promises of development are often made, the ground reality continues to reflect severe neglect. The deteriorating roads are also reportedly affecting local businesses. Several traders claimed that many customers are reluctant to visit the town due to the difficult road conditions, leading to losses for small and medium-scale businesses.

Light rain exposes poor drainage, locals protest

Agartala, May 27: Severe resentment erupted among residents of Kashipur Cooperative area under Ward No. 9 of Khayerpur Assembly Constituency on Wednesday after light rainfall led to massive waterlogging, causing immense inconvenience to local people. According to residents, the area has been facing drainage problems for the past several years, affecting nearly 200 to 250 families. Locals alleged that despite repeated appeals and approaches to various authorities, no permanent solution has been implemented so far. The residents claimed that even after nearly eight years of representation under MLA Ratan Chakraborty, the longstanding drainage issue remains unresolved. With rainwater accumulating on roads and residential areas after a brief spell of rain, normal life was disrupted in the locality. School-going students, office-goers, and daily commuters faced major difficulties while moving through the waterlogged roads.
