

Cong, NCP (SP) seek blanket farm loan waiver

Waiver scheme announced by the Mahayuti govt is “misleading” for farmers.

MUMBAI: The opposition Congress and NCP (SP) on Monday demanded an unconditional farm loan waiver for farmers by scrapping eligibility conditions, terming the similar scheme announced by the Mahayuti government as “misleading” for farmers.

Speaking during the discussion on supplementary demands in the state assembly, Congress Legislature Party (CLP) leader Vijay Wadettiwar said the loan waiver announcement was “a deception”, claiming that stringent conditions would leave a majority of farmers outside its ambit.

He said, contrary to the government's claim that 56 lakh farmers would benefit from the loan waiver scheme, only 12 lakh agriculturists are likely to qualify because of conditions such as regular repayment of crop loans on four occasions.

Wadettiwar alleged that thousands of farmers without a Farmer ID have been excluded from the

scheme. “The government should scrap all conditions and announce a blanket loan waiver for all farmers,” he said.

The Congress leader said the implementation

of Budgetary promises on sustainable agriculture, farmer welfare, women, tribals, OBCs and employment generation remained poor, claiming that “only five per cent” of the funds allocated to the agriculture sector had been utilised.

Wadettiwar said many paddy farmers in the Vidarbha region were yet to receive payments for procurement made during the previous kharif season, affecting their ability to finance cultivation for the current season.

Wondering whether it is a loan waiver or an eligibility test, Patil said farmers who needed the most assistance were being excluded.

He urged the government to announce a universal loan waiver without discrimination and withdraw all restrictive conditions.

Patil alleged that insur-

ance companies collected about Rs 56,800 crore in

premiums from farmers and the Centre and state governments between 2016 and 2025, while earning a net profit of Rs 6,944.11 crore since 2022. He sought details of claims rejected on technical grounds and demanded strict action against companies that allegedly denied compensation to farmers.

Woman pilot injured as aircraft crashes

Training aircraft crashes near Kasganj, hits power line.

KASGANJ: A woman pilot was injured on Monday after a two-seater trainee aircraft crashed into a field here, police said.

The aircraft, which had taken off from Aligarh airport on a training sortie, crashed near the police lines in the Kasganj district headquarters area, damaging a high-tension power line before hitting the ground, they said.

Superintendent of Police O P Singh said the aircraft was flying over the area when it suddenly began losing altitude and crashed into a nearby field. During the descent, it struck a

high-tension electricity line, snapping the wire and causing extensive damage to the aircraft.

The injured trainee pilot, identified as Kainaat, daughter of Qadar Khan and a resident of Maharashtra, was rushed to the district hospital by ambulance. Doctors said her condition was stable and she was undergoing treatment. Police and senior administrative officials rushed to the spot along with rescue teams after receiving information about the crash. The accident site was cordoned off as a precautionary measure.

Officials from the electricity department and other concerned agencies also reached the site to restore the damaged power line and ensure public safety.

JAIPUR: The arid Shekhawati region, comprising Churu, Sikar and Jhunjhunu districts, is set to be the biggest beneficiary of the implementation of the long-pending 1994 Upper Yamuna River Board (UYRB) agreement. Water from the Yamuna is expected to reduce dependence on groundwater, which is the primary source of drinking water across much of the Shekhawati

A memorandum of understanding (MoU) signed between Rajasthan and Haryana in Delhi on Monday paves the way for the supply of drinking water to the drought-prone districts of Churu, Jhunjhunu and Sikar in the initial phase, an official said.

Shekhawat is one of the most water-stressed

regions in the desert state of Rajasthan.

Under the agreement, water will be transported from the Hathnikund Barrage in Haryana.

“Water will be transported to a reservoir in Churu district from Hathnikund Barrage through a pipeline. From the reservoir, the water will be distributed to Churu, Sikar and Jhunjhunu,” a senior official of the state water resources department told PTI.

He said that the MoU was a major milestone towards the project. The area has historically faced water shortages due to low rainfall and excessive groundwater extraction.
