

LDF's women pension plan flawed, will review it: VDS

Thiruvananthapuram: The Kerala govt will examine complaints regarding the implementation of the women's security pension scheme only in the future, before deciding on its continuation, chief minister V D Satish Kumar said on Monday.
Replying to an adjournment motion, Satish Kumar, a CPM MLA, the CM alleged that the previous LDF govt had announced the scheme in the last month of its tenure.

The LDF govt was in power for 120 months. Yet, it announced the women's security pension scheme only in the last month of its tenure, he said. He also said that the govt could not commit to continuing the scheme without first examining the allegations regarding its implementation and the manner in which beneficiaries were initially identified, the number was subsequently reduced to 8.4 lakh, indicating serious flaws in the selection process, he said.
Satish Kumar said the govt had earmarked Rs.1,500 crore for the scheme in the 2026-27 budget and clarified that no decision had been taken to discontinue it. However, he said the govt could not commit to continuing the scheme without first examining the allegations regarding its implementation and the manner in which beneficiaries were initially identified, the number was subsequently reduced to 8.4 lakh, indicating serious flaws in the selection process, he said.

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SC declines urgent hearing on plea for CBI-led probe into 'donation chori'

New Delhi: Supreme Court on Monday refused urgent hearing on a plea by two advocates seeking investigation by CBI-led multi-disciplinary probe agencies into the alleged embezzlement of Ayodhya Ram Mandir funds, created from donations of devotees for religious and charitable purposes.
The petitioners - Delhi-based advocates Ajay Kumar Rai and Dinesh Yadav - said the allegations are serious and require urgent directives from the court for a multi-disciplinary investigation to identify the culprits. However, a bench of Justices M M Sundresh and Shree Naga said, "Heavens are not going to fall if the petition is heard after the court resumes normal business on July 12 after the end of partial working days."

Trust Brings Forward Meeting To Take Call On Resignations

Lucknow: The investigation into the alleged embezzlement of Ram Temple donations gathered pace Monday as Ayodhya police recorded the statement of Champat Rai, the Shri Ram Jammabhooni Trust secretary who had resigned on June 27.
Police officers confirmed the development, saying statements of several trust functionaries and others associated with the temple's donation management system were being recorded to piece together the sequence of events and verify the SOPs followed in the handling of offerings.

According to sources familiar with the investigation, a police team led by a deputy SP questioned Rai for more than two hours. Investigators reportedly sought detailed information on the entire donation management process.
Sources said the questioning was aimed at understanding the institutional mechanism governing temple donations, identifying the responsibilities of various officials at different stages of the process, and examining whether any procedural lapses may have created opportunities for the alleged embezzlement.
This is the first time Rai's statement has been recorded. Investigators are corroborating his statement with financial records, bank documents, CCTV footage, evidence and other material collected during investigation. Anil Mishra, a member of the trust, too had resigned along with Rai.

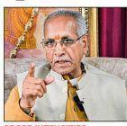
The trust is expected to take a decision on their resignations at its next meeting, originally scheduled for July 14 but now advanced to July 6.
Sources said police are expected to record Mishra's statement next, while the statements of several other individuals associated with the trust have already been taken or are currently being recorded.

He resigned from academics after spending one and a half years in jail during the Ram temple agitation and went on to dedicate his time to VHP. He is now VHP vice-president. A special court in Ayodhya sent Monday the eight accused in alleged temple donation theft to judicial custody till July 10. Police chose not to seek their arrest, pressing ahead with collection of documentary financial and witness evidence, report Patshikrit Chakraborty and Arshad Afzal Khan.

A special judge Rishi Verma heard the matter through video conferencing before extending judicial custody till July 10. The arrested men will remain in Ayodhya district jail until their next hearing.
Among those facing allegations are prime suspects Ram Shankar Yadav alias Tirmu Yadav, a former driver associated with the temple trust, and Anand Mishra, 26, employed through a bank's outsourcing agency for counting cash received. Others are Lavush Mishra, Avinash Shukla, Karanesh Pandey, Mahesh Yadav, Ramabharat Mishra and Subhash Srivastava.

Ayodhya circle officer Ashutosh Tiwari, who is investigating the case, attended the hearing. Police also produced a witness statement of Mishra. Special public prosecutor Umesh Dubey said the accused had been in jail from June 26. "Because investigators did not seek police custody, the court released the accused to judicial custody for 14 more days," he said. Family members of some of the accused visited the jail during the day.
